PAYMENT OF BASE FEE & PROPERTY MANAGEMENT FEE BY WAY OF ISSUE OF NEW UNITS IN MAPLETREE NORTH ASIA COMMERCIAL TRUST (“MNACT”)

27 April 2022 – Mapletree North Asia Commercial Trust Management Ltd., as manager (the “**Manager**”) of Mapletree North Asia Commercial Trust (“**MNACT**”), wishes to announce that a total of 11,591,728 new units (“**Units**”) in MNACT have been issued on 27 April 2022 at S\$1.2026 per Unit for the following purposes:

1. 7,384,974 Units issued to the Manager as payment of the Base Fee (as defined in the trust deed dated 14 February 2013 (as amended) constituting MNACT (“**Trust Deed**”)) for the period from 1 October 2021 to 31 March 2022.
2. 4,206,754 Units issued to Mapletree North Asia Property Management Limited (the “**Property Manager**”) as payment of Property Management Fee (as defined in the Trust Deed) relating to Festival Walk and Gateway Plaza for the period from 1 October 2021 to 31 March 2022.

The issue price of the Units is based on the 10-day volume weighted average price for the units up to 31 March 2022.

The issuance of these Units is in accordance with the disclosure in the IPO prospectus of MNACT dated 27 February 2013.

The Manager has elected to receive 100% of the Base Fee in the form of units. Under the Trust Deed, the Manager is entitled to receive a base fee of 10% per annum of the distributable income of MNACT. In relation to the Japan Properties¹, the asset management services are provided by Mapletree Investments Japan Kabushiki Kaisha (the “**Japan Asset Manager**”). In view of the fees payable in cash to the Japan Asset Manager for the Japan Properties, the Manager has elected to waive the Base Fee, which it is otherwise entitled to under the Trust Deed for as long as the Manager and the Japan Asset Manager are wholly-owned by Mapletree Investments Pte Ltd and the Japan

Asset Manager continues to receive an asset management fee¹ for the Japan Properties.

The Manager has elected to pay the Property Manager the Property Management Fee relating to Festival Walk and Gateway Plaza in the form of units. For Sandhill Plaza, the Manager has elected to pay Property Manager the Property Management Fee in cash from the date of acquisition on 17 June 2015. For the Japan Properties, the Manager has elected to pay the property management fees to Mapletree Management Services Japan Kabushiki Kaisha (the “**Japan Property Manager**”) in cash from the respective acquisition dates on 25 May 2018 for six office properties, on 28 February 2020 for two office properties and on 18 June 2021 for an office property. For The Pinnacle Gangnam, the Manager has elected to pay Mapletree Korea Management Co., Ltd. (the “**Korea Property Manager**”) the property management fee in cash.

Following this issuance, the Manager holds 203,131,199 units and the Property Manager holds 99,992,982 units. Total number of units in issue as at 27 April 2022 is 3,539,565,884.
